SUBJECT: Statutory Disqualification

DATE: August 10, 2016

Effective **August 24, 2016** BOX Options Exchange ("BOX") is amending BOX Rule 2040 regarding Participants and persons associated with Participants who become subject to a statutory disqualification under the Exchange Act.

Changes to BOX Rule 2040 include:

• A Participant or person associated with a Participant that becomes subject to a statutory disqualification and who wants to continue as a Participant of the Exchange or in association with a Participant, must now submit a request to the Exchange seeking to continue as a Participant or in association with a Participant notwithstanding the statutory disqualification within thirty (30) days of becoming subject to the statutory disqualification.

Requests may be submitted to regulation@boxregulation.com.

- A Participant or person associated with a Participant whose request to become a
 Participant is denied or conditioned, or who is not permitted to continue on as or be an
 associated with a Participant may now appeal the Exchange's decision under BOX Rule
 13000.
- The Exchange may now waive the provisions of BOX Rule 2040 when a proceeding is pending before another SRO or similar association to determine whether to permit a Participant or associated person to become or continue being a Participant or associated person notwithstanding a statutory disqualification.
