**SUBJECT: CAT ClientOrderID Requirement for BOX Participants**  
**DATE: September 14, 2018**

---

BOX Exchange LLC ("BOX" or the "Exchange") expects to commence Phase 1 reporting into the Consolidated Audit Trail on **November 15, 2018**. Accordingly, it is now mandatory for BOX Participants using both FIX and SAIL to include a ClientOrderID within each Order submitted to the Exchange.

The ClientOrderID is a unique identifier assigned by the Participant. Uniqueness must be guaranteed within a single trading day. Participants who submit multiday orders should consider embedding a date within this field to assure uniqueness across days.
